VISA/TRC INFORMATION

Students, lecturers, and researchers from non-EU countries who wish to study, work, or conduct research in Poland must obtain a visa or Temporary Residence Card at the nearest Polish consulate or embassy.

Insurance

► Insurance requirements differ for EU and non-EU citizens. EU students are generally covered by their home country's health insurance, while non-EU students need to arrange their own insurance for the duration of their stay.

- **EU Citizens**

Students from EU countries should obtain the European Health Insurance Card in their country of origin before traveling to Poland. The European Health Insurance Card gives access to the Polish public health system.

- **NON-EU Citizens**

Students who are not European Union citizens must obtain a valid private health insurance (a copy of the insurance policy will be demanded in order to enroll at the University).

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STUDENTS SERVICES

The main campus is fully Wi-Fi enabled, with access to online services for education and administration. Students benefit from state-of-the-art labs, research facilities, libraries, study rooms, computer labs and cafeterias.

COSTS OF LIVING

The cost of living for a student in Poland depends on various factors such as accommodation, meals, and personal lifestyle. On average, students can expect to spend between 1500 to 2000 PLN per month (approx. 330-450 EUR).

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ACCOMMODATION

There is a dormitory available in a neighboring city of Sosnowiec, with the cost of 800 PLN (approx. 176 EUR) per month.
