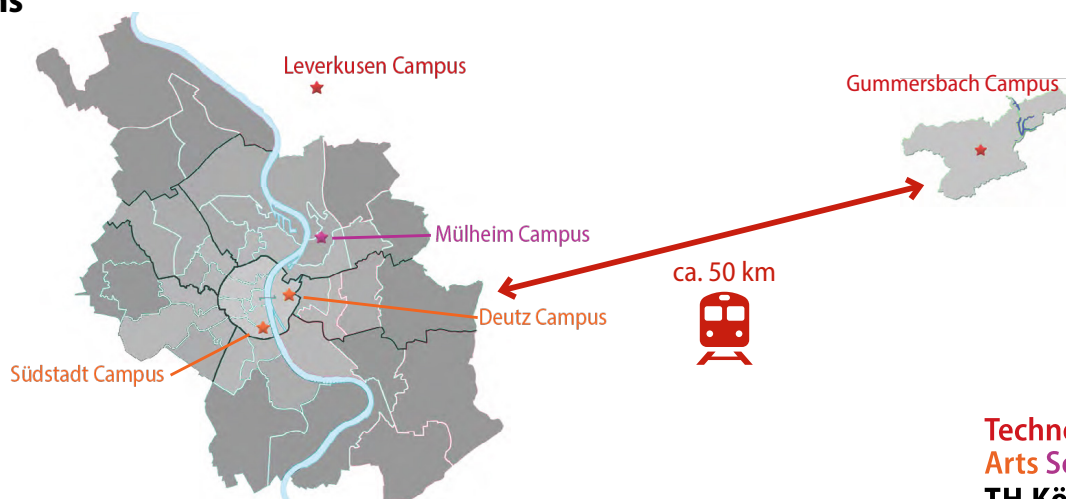

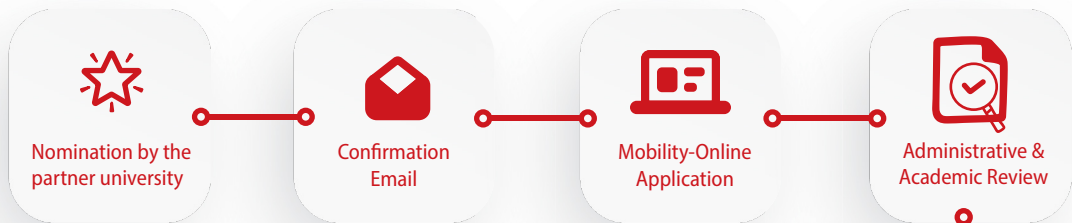

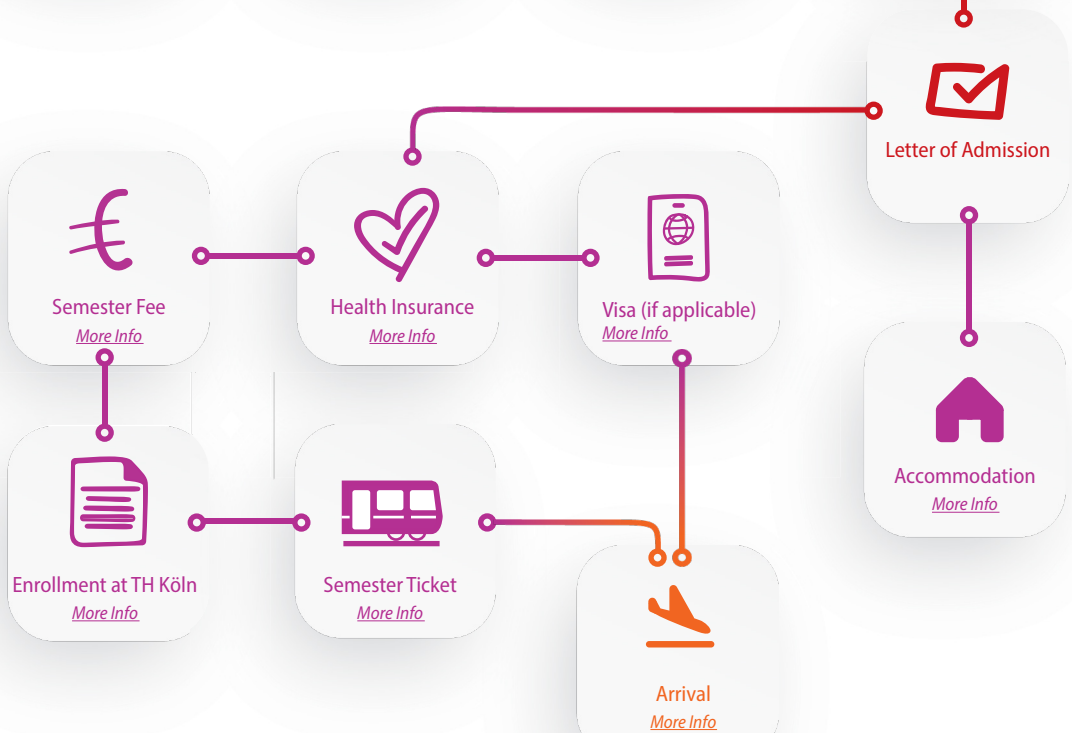

Exchange Student Timeline

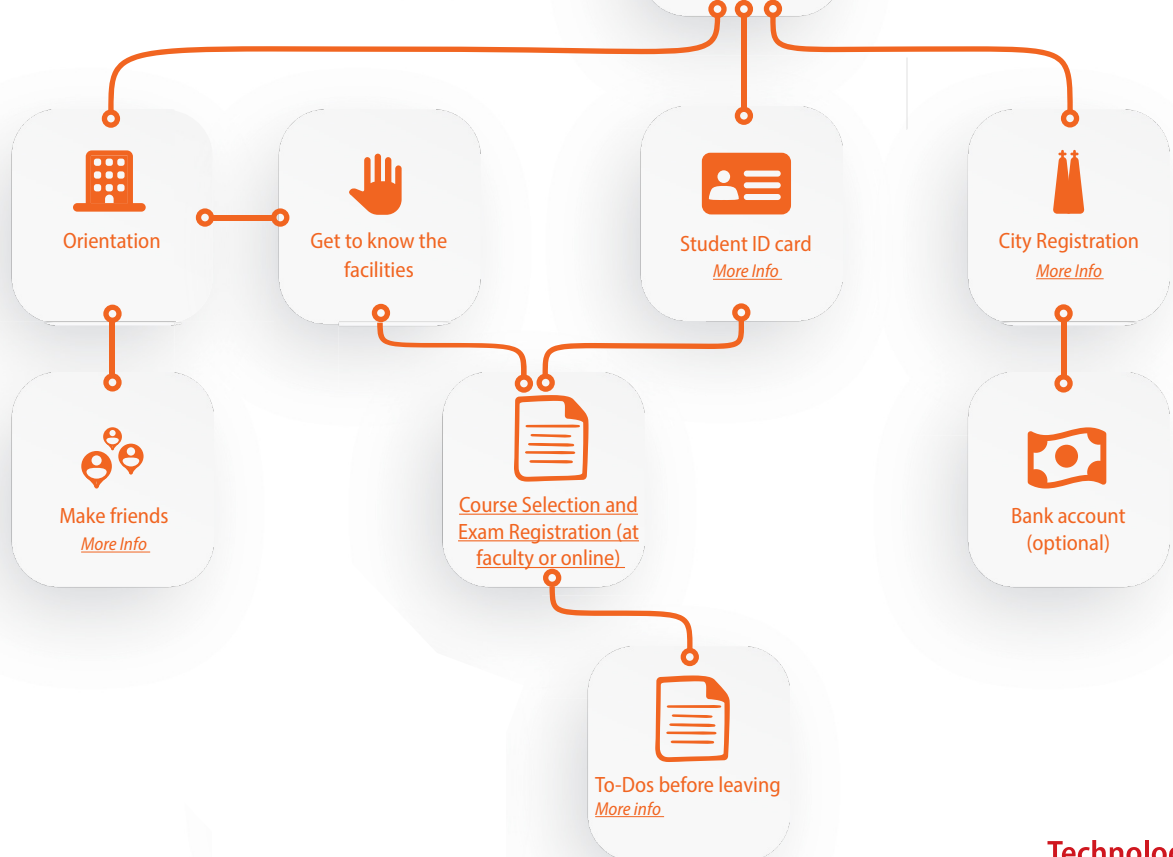

Useful Information for Students

Deadlines

Complete your application by:

May 1st for the upcoming winter semester / study year

November 1st for the upcoming summer semester

Submit your LA BTM by:

June 1st for the upcoming winter semester / study year

December 1st for the upcoming summer semester

Application Steps

Once your coordinator at your home university has nominated you via our platform, you will receive an E-mail with a registration link for your *Mobility-Online* application as well as other vital information on several topics (e.g. your faculty).

Make sure to complete your personal data, indicate an emergency contact (this cannot be yourself!), and upload a language certificate. In case you are a native speaker please upload a document mentioning this.

Once your registration and the upload of your personal data have passed formal review, you can continue through the application process. For ERASMUS students, it is obligatory to submit a Learning Agreement next. All other students (global exchange students, freemovers) please check with their Departmental Coordinator at TH Köln if a Learning Agreement is needed. As soon as your application (and, if applicable, your Learning Agreement) has been confirmed by the host faculty at TH Köln, you will be informed by E-mail that you can print out your Letter of Admission and start preparing for your digital [enrollment](#).

Semester Fee

All students will have to pay a semester fee of approx. € 350 for each semester at TH Köln. This fee covers public transportation in all of Germany. Students will receive their MultiCa (earliest March/ September 1st) only after having paid the semester fee. The MultiCa is their student ID card and valid in our libraries, student cafeterias and as proof of identity for exams.

Accommodation

Unfortunately, TH Köln does not offer on-campus dormitories. Information on how to search for accommodation in Cologne/Gummersbach can be found on our [website](#). Students can apply at the [Kölner Studierendenwerk](#) (KSTW), which offers student accommodation (no guarantee of an offer) and should search at the same time on their own on the private housing market. Please apply early and be open for more than one choice to make sure you get a room, even if it is not in the location you would have preferred.

Required Coursework & Grading System

In order to gain credits, all students have to actively participate in the coursework and exams (or other relevant assessments) of their chosen courses. Be prepared to do coursework and exams even if your home university would not require it. TH Köln generally does not issue certificates of attendance for courses.
