Cost of living – For Paris	Thanks to the student card, given upon arrival, students have access to lots of discounts in and around Paris. <u>Housing:</u> rent/month around 800€* <u>Restaurant:</u> Less than 5€ for a student meal in a University restaurant, with the student card. Around 15€ for a regular meal*. <u>Transportation:</u> one-way ticket (local transport): 1,90€* Navigo pass “Imagine R”: 350€* for the academic year, for students under 26 years old. Unlimited travel in Ile-de-France. <u>Leisure:</u> Lots of museums in Paris are free for students under 26 years old, others provide discounts.
