Nominations	Deadlines for nominations: • 15 April for the autumn semester. • 7 October for the spring semester. (Application deadline for students 15 October.)
Applications	Kristiania University of Applied Sciences uses an online nomination and application system for incoming exchange students. Before a student can apply, their home institution must officially nominate them using the Nomination Portal. Nominated students are then invited to register an application in the Application Portal. Instructions on how to use the portals may be found on our website.
Shorter exchanges	All programmes are open for shorter exchanges.
Courses offered in English	Kristiania UAS offers a wide variety of bachelor's and master's courses taught in English. These courses, including past courses, are listed on our website.

Course structure and study plans	Please see the available subjects/courses in English on our website .
Structure of study programmes	Bachelor: 3 years, 180 ECTS. Most courses give 7,5 ECTS. Master: Modules of 4-6 weeks. 2 years full-time, 3 years part-time, 120 ECTS.
Grading system	The Norwegian grading system consists of two grading scales: a Pass/Fail scale, and A-F scale where E is the lowest passing grade. A Pass/Fail Grade can't be converted to a letter grade. The grading scale has the following qualitative descriptions: A – Excellent; B – Very good; C – Good; D – Satisfactory; E – Sufficient; F – Fail. The scale is used absolutely (criterion-referenced assessment). The Pass/Fail scale can't be converted to a letter scale
Transcript of record	The student can order a transcript of record in "Studentweb" for a limited time after the exchange (approx. 6 months). A digitally signed transcript (PDF) will be generated automatically in the document folder in the student profile.

Evaluations	Students will be sent evaluations twice each semester, one mid-term and one final evaluation. The evaluations are submitted anonymously if the student wishes.
