Structure of study	Bachelor: 3 years, 180 ECTS. Most courses give 7,5 ECTS. Master: Modules of 4-6 weeks. 2 years full-time, 3 years part-time, 120
programmes	ECTS.
Grading system	The Norwegian grading system consists of two grading scales: Pass/Fail and A-F where E is the lowest passing grade. A Pass/Fail Grade can't be converted to a letter grade.  The grading scale has the following qualitative descriptions: A – Excellent; B – Very good; C – Good; D – Satisfactory; E – Sufficient; F – Fail. The scale is used absolutely (criterion-referenced assessment).
Transcript of record	The student can order a transcript of record in "Studentweb" for a limited time after the exchange (approx. 6 months). A digitally signed transcript (PDF) will be generated automatically in the document folder in your profile.
